FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When is the 2011 parade and what is the route?

The 2012 parade will be on Saturday, Feb 11th at 10am starting at Robert and Ciruti Sts \in Olde Towne Slidell. The route is approximately one mile square through Olde Towne.

What is the theme for the 2012 parade?

Our theme is Canines Of The Caribbean creative costuming is encouraged as well as unique float design.

How does my dog become a member of the Krewe and 'march' in the parade?

Every dog needs to complete a registration form and pay the membership/parade fee. Various levels of membership are available from \$40 applications are even taken the day of the parade, but come early!

Registration can be completed online at www.KreweDePaws.com or in person at Double Discount in Olde Towne Slidell or at Cafe Du Bone on Gause . All walking krewe members will receive parade credentials prior to the parade. All dogs must be socialized and up-to-date with their shots and show proof prior to registration.

What costumes or "floats" can we do?

Our members are very creative in their dog and human costumes, we encourage you to let your imagination go and create something wonderful. We encourage the use of decorated shopping carts, wagons, etc

What do I receive for my registration fees?

You will receive the right to parade and associate with your fellow dog lovers and the undying gratitude of the many unfortunate animals that receive our grants.(if any is left over after expenses)

Each krewe member's registration includes at least one human escort. Additional human guests can walk with the krewe member by purchasing an escort pass for \$8.

Where do I go the day of the parade?

Plan to arrive early so that the Krewe member (and the human escorts) have ample time to transition into the proper state of mind for this experience. The pre-parade registration starts at 8:30am. Parking is available throughout Olde Towne. It is easy to walk from any point in Olde Towne. There is plenty of green space to relax and, of course, doggie and people drinks will be flowing along with all the appropriate food items to consume at will. It is the pre-parade Party, so plan to hang and witness the mass of paws take to the streets of Olde Towne and return to Abigails, where the Party will continue.
